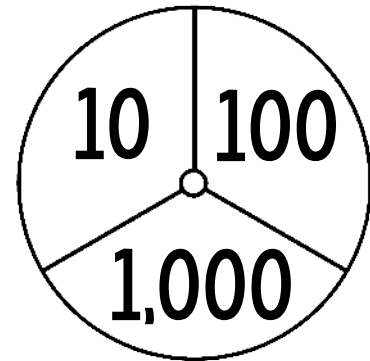


# Multiplying by Multiples of 10



For each problem roll a die one, two, three, or four times and record the digits rolled. The number of blank lines show how many times to roll the die. Then, use a paperclip as a spinner and write the multiple of ten the paperclip landed on. Write an equation to multiply the number rolled with the die by the multiple of ten spun. Be sure to write the answer to the equation. Finally, write the number that is ten times larger than the product in the equation.
