

Funland Festival

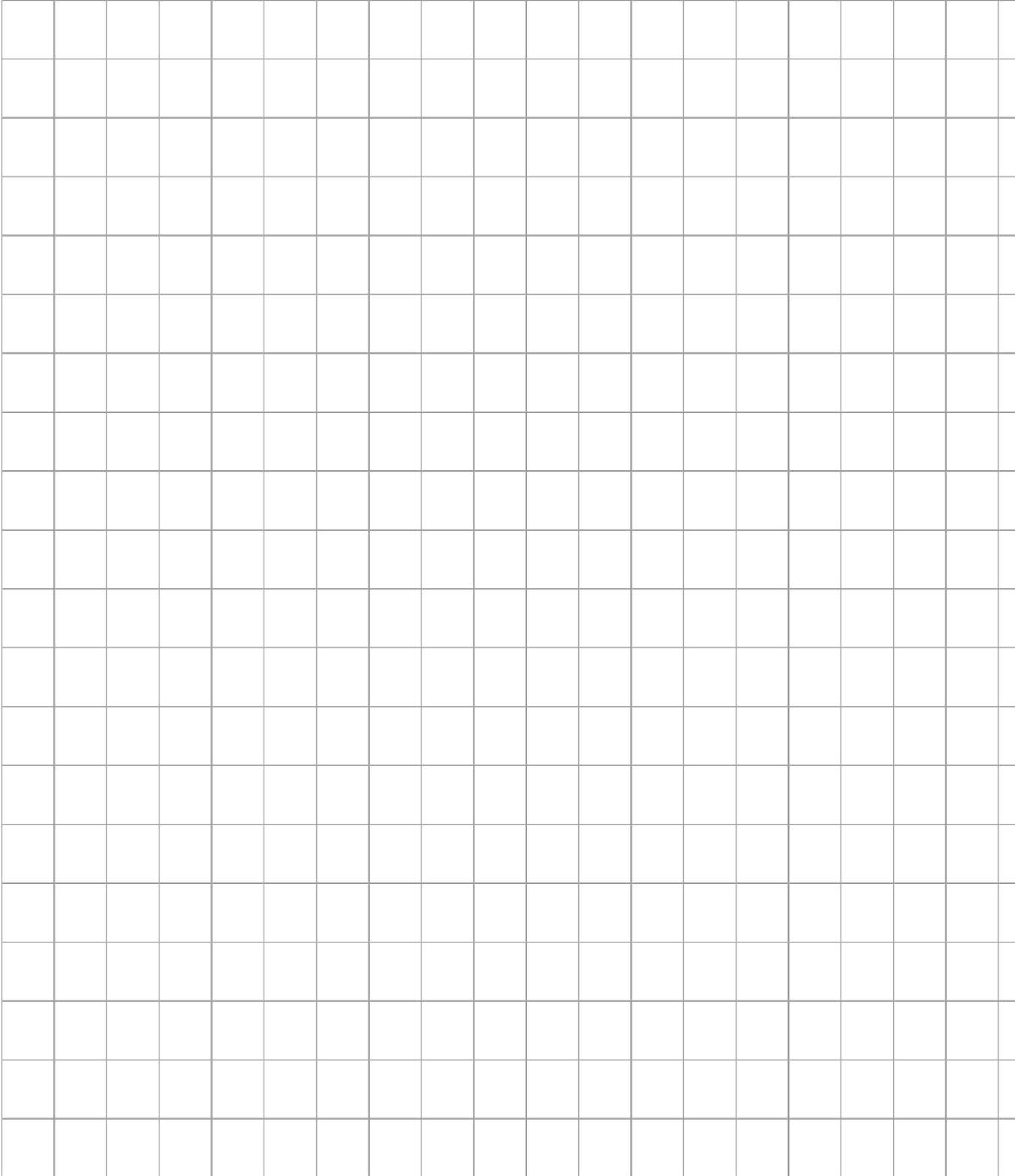

Activity	Requirements	Activity	Requirements
 <p>Bottle Toss</p>	<p>This activity has an area of 24 square units.</p>	 <p>Cup Stacking</p>	<p>The cup stacking booth has a perimeter of 24 units with the smallest area possible.</p>
 <p>Horseshoes</p>	<p>The horseshoes have a perimeter of 22 units.</p>	 <p>Balloon Darts</p>	<p>The balloon darts activity has a perimeter of 24 units with the largest area possible.</p>
 <p>Fishing for Ducks</p>	<p>The area for the ducks is 40 square units. The booth is 8 units long.</p>	 <p>Spin the Wheel</p>	<p>This activity has an area of 48 square units and a perimeter of 38 units.</p>
 <p>Face Painting</p>	<p>The perimeter of face painting is 32 units. One side is 6 units.</p>	 <p>Whack-a-Ball</p>	<p>The whack-a-ball booth is NOT a quadrilateral and has a perimeter of 26 units.</p>
 <p>Basketball Toss</p>	<p>This booth has an area of 15 square units. It's NOT a quadrilateral.</p>	<p>There needs to be at least 1 sq. unit of space between each activity.</p> <p>You can also add your favorite food booths.</p>
